Women, Junior and Senior must choose to play in their category or open events (Same rule for Classic and Speedball events). If there are less than 8 teams in the Junior/Women/Senior Doubles they can exceptionally play in the Open Doubles with the same partner. However if a Junior/Women/Senior team has chosen to play the OD category, they will not be allowed to play in the Junior/Women/Senior category. In that case with 8 teams or less, there will be no qualification for WS, WD, JS, JD, SS, SD. Format = SKO 3/5.

**NOTE: Junior Singles and Doubles are played on Saturday – the Schedule and number of Qualification rounds depends on the number of players. Additionally, all male Juniors are allowed to play Open Singles and all female Juniors are allowed to play Women Singles on Friday!**

### REFEREE & DRESS CODE

The tournament fee includes 5€ for the Referee fees. Referee receive payment based on their level and number of matches officiated.

This fee does not guarantee a referee for all matches. There is no referring during qualification rounds. In elimination, if no referee after 10 minutes, the match must start. All Referees must wear ITSF referee shirt displaying their referee level.

Some competitions might be played over 2 days depending on the timing and number of registered players. In this case, players **MUST** attend the whole competition to avoid forfeit.

\* DYP format will depend on the number of registered players. \*\* At the qualification time limit, we will just finish the round to be sure all players have played the same number of matches. Number of matches played will depend on tournament



### TEAM WARM UP FORMAT

- 4 players make a team. No seeded teams
- Each player will play between 2 to 4 times in Doubles ONLY.
- A match is one game first to 21 points. 20/20 is a tie in qualification and penalty in elimination.
- After 5 balls are played (5/0 - 4-1 or 3-2), a new double enter the game until the end of the match
- 2 time out per team during a full match
- For each match, players are registered in order A, B, C and D. Doubles are then playing in this order : AB - CD - AC - BD (and repeat in this order)

### SWISS SYSTEM FORMAT

The qualifications competitions will be played under the Swiss system :

- Team Warm Up (See format above)
- Open Doubles, Women, Juniors and Senior
- Open Singles, Women, Junior and Seniors

### QUALIFICATION FORMAT

**Top 12 Men and Top 6 Women and Top 3 Senior will be seeded according to ITSF Ranking.**

**The number of the qualification matches will depend on the number of the players, the tournament progression and player performance.**

**The winner to shall announce just his name (NOT the score).**

**The Qualification match format is one game to 8 (NO TIE).**

Ranking will be based on teams points then total points of your opponent following by total points of the opponent of your opponent. B1 stand for points of my opponent and B2 stand for points of the opponent of your opponent. If there is still a tie, we'll see the best opponent ranking that you played against.

### ELIMINATION FORMAT

100% Players will be qualified in different divisions.

The players in the Open category will be divided into 3 brackets: Pro, Division B, Division C and in the Women and Senior category in Pro and Division B. Groups ranking will be gathered and will determine the final ITSF ranking. Elimination match format is SKO 3/5. First to 5 per game (2 points difference up to 8 maximum on the last game).

**DELAYS: If 9 min after a game has been called, the game hasn't started and no recall has been made, both teams loose a set even if one team is present at the table. Similarly, they will lose 2 sets after 12min. Both teams will be eliminated after 15min have passed since the match had been called and no game had started.**

## RULES

**Article 1 :** Regular member federations can send teams to participate in the ECL 2017. Participating teams are winners from the 2016 season or 2015/2016 season (depending on whether a federation's season is aligned with the calendar year or academic year)

Associate member federations can send teams to participate in the ECL 2017 only after approval by the ITSF federation assessment commission.

**Men :** ONLY ITSF Regular member which have 2 divisions or at least 12 teams in their leagues can benefit from a wild Card.

**Women :** ONLY ITSF Regular member which have at least 6 teams in their leagues can benefit from a wild card.

**Article 2 : “1 player, 1 club”** Players cannot represent a club in the ECL if they have played for any other club during the whole ITSF season (January 1st to Dec. 31st, 2017) in highest division of the Club National League in one of the participating countries with a Public National League\*. It is the responsibility of National Federations to monitor this and to provide the list of their national leagues to ITSF.

\*The expression “having a Public National League” means that a National Federation has for minimum one national-level league (men or women or mixed) able to qualify for the European Champions League. Information about ranking and participating players will have to be published by each federation on the internet.

**Article 3 :** Only players member of a National Federation, or players with at least one year's residence in that country, having a public national league, can play the European Champions League. (Not applicable for Non European Players)

If you are a male player and you want to play ECL in 2017, these are the 2 requirements:

1. Your national federation, or the country where your residence have been for more than one year, is organizing a Public National League in 2017.
2. You are not allowed to play for any other club during the whole ITSF season (January 1st to Dec. 31st, 2017) in a National League in one of the countries with a Public National League.

If you are a female player and you want to play women ECL in 2017, these are the 2 requirements:

1. Your National Federation, or the country where your residence have been for more than one year, is organizing a Public National League in 2017.(not necessary a women one).
2. You are not allowed to play for any other club during the whole ITSF season (January 1st to Dec. 31st, 2017) in a National Women League in one of the countries with a Public National League. Women players are allowed to play ONLY women ECL and cannot play for the men ECL.

**Article 4 :** The decision if players (who are not playing ECL) are allowed to play in different national leagues is under the responsibility of each single National Federation.

## MATCH FORMAT

- **Men:** 6 + 3 reserve players (minimum 6 players to make up a team)
- **Women:** 4 + 2 reserve players (minimum 4 players to make up a team)

**PENALTY**

In case of tie scoring during the last game (20/20), team will play penalty

- Each team has to choose 4 players (player n°1 to n°4). Player n°1 shoots against player n°1 ...etc (1 shoot/player)
- Only one draw. The winner choses to shoot first or to defend
- Each player will shoot and defend. 1 goal = 1 point. The team which has most points after 4 shoots win the match. In case of tie score after 4 shoot, dead head will be setup by begining with player n°1 (team win as soon as duel between 2 players is won)
- Both players have 30 seconds to prepare to shoot. No overtime allowed.
- The 4 players of the same team will play on the same side of the table. Only handle of 3 bars can be change.


